It was time to catch the ferry so I tried to hop on the bike, but I was a bit drunk and kept falling off. After a few attempts I took off down to the harbour.

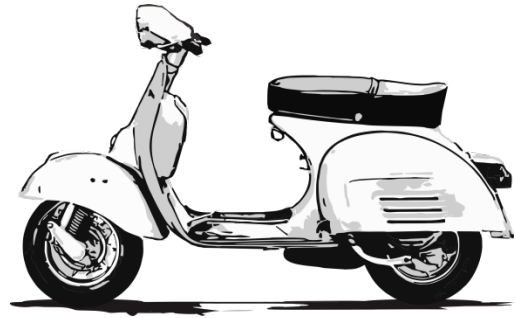
On the way down, going around the corner I hit a pot hole and smashed into the wall. I was badly hurt. The police came to see me, followed by the doctor and they patched me up.

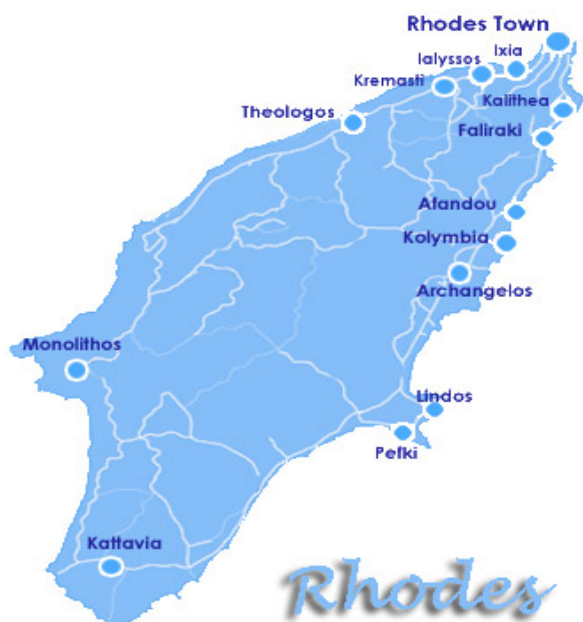


Discuss with tutor: What are the main ideas in this story?

Rhodes is an island in the Aegean Sea, between Turkey and the mainland of Greece. Geographically, it's like Rottneest!



The capital of the island is also called Rhodes (or Rhodos, by the Greeks).
